

The True Name of Our Savior

Greetings to you that read this article. This one is special. It is about the sacred name of our Father and His Son -- in the Hebrew language mind you! This is not some recent discovery. It has been taught publically since way back in the early 1930's here in America. I have received this knowledge from universities, scholars, dictionaries, libraries, Hebrew Bibles, and revelation of the Holy Spirit. Please check the Internet. You will find a lot of churches listed under the sacred name Yahshua.

Some may ask, "Why is the name of God and Jesus in our bibles?" That's simple; because you have an English Bible. Our Savior was given a Hebrew name well over 2000 years ago. Who would dare tamper and change such a holy name? Our Savior has a name that is above every name, (Ph. 2:9). The name Yahshua carries the message "**Yahweh Saves**" in Hebrew. His name is the same as his Father's -- **Yah**. The initial part for both Father and Son is Yah...one name and the same. Zachariah 14:9 says, "...in that day shall there be one Lord and his name one. One name! "**Yah**"weh and "**Yah**"shua. Did the Son come in His Father's name? Absolutely! (Jn. 5:43).

Friend, have you ever thought that there is far more truth than you have learned? Do you prove all things? The name Yahshua means "Yahweh Saves" in the Hebrew language. Does Yahweh save? Yes! Your Almighty will come and save His people, (Is. 35:4). He was and still is saving, in the person of His Son Yahshua, reconciling the world unto Himself in Messiah, (2 Cor. 5:19). Did you get it? "Yahweh saves" is what Yahshua's name is saying in Hebrew, not in Greek or English. I am thankful for the transliteration of the holy names Yahweh and Yahshua, Elohim, Emmanuel, and others from their original meaning. For instance, **Emmanuel** means "Elohim" is with us, not a pagan word "God" is with us.

There are many gods (idols) in the world. Even Satan is referred to as the god of this world, but to us there is but one Elohim (god), (1 Cor. 8:6). Do you wish to grieve our Father Almighty calling Him "lord (Baal) our god" instead of by His true identity? **Seriously**, is it acceptable or agreeable to compare Him with pagan titles or names? I don't think so! In Ex. 23:13 it says, "All in all things that I have said unto you be circumspect: and make no mention of the name of other gods, neither let it be heard out of thy mouth." Also read Hosea 2:17. Can you say "Amen" to that? Get back with me.
